

# Odyssey 2000<sup>®</sup> Road Memo # 1 (South Africa)

Re: Mail stops from Greece to D.C. (for security purposes, not for released on the web. Private email lists only)

Here is the next set of mail stops from Athens to Washington D. C. The first is a little tight, so make sure you suggest priority type (FedEx and other overnight deliveries) mailings only. Here are other suggestions:

1. When possible, allow at least three weeks for mail to arrive.
2. The sender's address needs to be clearly visible on the envelope/package.
3. Put "please hold for arrival" in the lower left hand corner of each envelope/package.
4. Keep in mind that certain items are likely be held up in customs, so your sender should know that items like food might not be a wise choice. In addition, you can expect to be charged customs and excise taxes on certain items.
5. Begin each address with the following:
