- Toilets: There are two facilities close to our camping area with about 6 women and 5 men's toilets.

Services:	San Diego has it all, but not close to the campground. However, the campground has plenty of services and activities.
Camping:	Surprisingly, Campland on the Bay is nearly completely filled with RV campers this time of year. However, they have been gracious enough to open their overflow camping area (normally closed this time of year) for our use. Ask for specific camping instructions. Incidentally, don't expect any grass for a long, long time.
Toilets:	One bathroom facility is close to close to our camping area. At least 2 others exist in the park.
Showers:	One shower facility is close to close. At least 2 others exist in the park.
Dinner:	Dinner will be at the campground from 5:00 to 6:30 pm tonight prepared Bob and the crew of the California Cookout Company.
Breakfast:	Breakfast is from 7:00 am to 8:30 am, again by the California Cookout Company
Tomorrow:	Welcome to Mexico and its wonderful people. Tomorrow will be our first day in a foreign nation and we won't be back in America until May. Expect a different language, culture, standard of living, life style, toilet facilities, water quality (don't drink), access to supplies and services, etc. The USA is relatively flat while Mexico becomes more hilly and pretty congested all the way to Rosarito. Be patient and alert. Suggest riding with another cyclist in Mexico (good idea in most countries). Begin carrying your passport with you at all times.
Stock up:	For the remainder of Odyssey, plan to carry plenty of food and water so you won't run out of goodies on long stretches of serviceless road. Even though there are plenty of services in Mexico, don't expect to be able to get anything along the route and you won't be disappointed or caught off guard.
